As always, it is important to be mindful of BEST PRACTICES for infection prevention in your day-to-day life, as well as when you are at work. The following precautions help reduce the risk of infection or spreading infection to others as outlined on the Government of Canada Public Health website:

- WASH YOUR HANDS **often** with soap and water for at least 20 seconds (Time enough to sing the “Happy Birthday” song TWICE)
- avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands
- stay home if you are sick
- when coughing or sneezing:
 - cover your mouth and nose with your arm or tissues to reduce the spread of germs
 - immediately dispose of any tissues you have used into the garbage as soon as possible and wash your hands afterwards
- avoid visiting people in hospitals or long-term care centres if you are sick
- **Be Informed and Be SAFE** – by visiting the Government Information website at Canada.ca/coronavirus
