This program is designed to assist schools by providing experiential education across our 130 acre outdoor classroom—emphasizing environmental stewardship & leadership. All activities will be coordinated by Program Director Ryan Lamoureux, and supervised by your student's teachers.

- Full change of clothes (use garbage bag/zip locks to waterproof in back-pack)
- Rubber Boots or Winter Boots
- Sturdy Hiking Shoes & Water Shoes/Sandals (depending on activities chosen)
- Nature Journal & Pencil/Eraser (if doing Visual Arts)
- Season Dependent: Bugspray, Sunscreen, Snowpants
