CODE OF CONDUCT

Our desire is to make Fair Havens the most enjoyable experience for all of our guests. With that in mind, we have a code of conduct to shape both our individual experiences, and that of our neighbours. Thank you for your co-operation in following this.

Bicycles & Skate Boards

All individuals 18 years and under must wear helmets while riding bicycles on grounds. Lights on bikes are required after dark.

Modesty

As a family-centered camp, we encourage modesty in all attire. We require that no revealing bathing suits be worn by those ages 13 and up, across all areas of the Fair Havens campgrounds, including the beach, splash park and pool area.

Quiet Time

Is in effect from 11:00PM to 7:30AM, and will be enforced. Individuals under the age of 18 are asked to stay on their campsites or in their accommodations after 11:00PM, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Campfires

Please keep fires to a maximum of 2ft high. All campfires must be supervised and put out by 11:00PM. Please do not burn anything other than paper, cardboard or wood (no plastics or painted/pressure treated wood).

Fire Bans

Fire bans, if announced by our region, will be posted and must be adhered to.

Restrictions

The following conduct is not permitted on the grounds of Fair Havens: abusive behaviour of any kind, malicious acts or physical aggression, threat to the safety of others, use of illicit drugs, alcohol or vaping. Fair Havens is a smoke-free environment. If you do smoke, please do so on the north side of Riverside Inn. Pets are not permitted onsite.

Fire

STOP DROP and ROLL

- Leave the building and pull fire alarm located at all building exits.
- Do your best to make sure all individuals are outside the building
- Call 911 from a safe location
- Contact the Main Office

Injury

- Contact the lifeguards or any other staff member with First Aid training. Once on scene, they will direct other staff members
- If the emergency is severe, call Emergency Medical Services (911)
- Offer assistance, but DO NOT ATTEMPT ANY FIRST AID THAT YOU ARE UNQUALIFIED FOR

Missing Persons

Report the missing person to the Main Office, and they will alert staff by 3 blasts on a whistle/bell. ALL STAFF will begin the planned Zone Search. Follow directions from Fair Havens Staff

Bear Sightings

Take steps to mitigate confrontation with the bear:

- Avoid leaving food outside
- Stay together as a group
- Be loud and make yourself look large
- DO NOT attempt to outrun the bear, outclimb the bear, or outswim the bear. It is better than you at these things.

Once away from the bear, contact the Main Office to inform them
